- 2. Did you carry any of these forwards into your adult life?
- 3. Identify one relationship where you can begin to play the honour game, what's your first move?

Finish by praying for one another and spend some time honouring each other...

Maybe do an exercise for instance take a piece of paper each and write your name on the bottom, then pass to the person on your left and each person writes something good about the person they see written on the bottom of the page. Once you've gone round the whole circle yours will come back to you and you can then read what everyone has said about you!
